

In an effort to raise awareness surrounding issues involving homelessness in both Gainesville and communities abroad, the chapter conducted a food and clothing drive for St. Francis House. The drive was concluded with a block party styled event at which people came and enjoyed live performances from student organizations and outside parties, as well as food trucks, a bounce house, and games. There was a station in which participants could create a bag lunch of PB&J, chips, and fruit and write some anonymous words of hope to the homeless. All the donations (collected both before AND during the event) were divided and dropped off at St. Francis house and Grace Marketplace the following week, as were the bagged lunches. Over one thousand pounds of donations were collected. Approximately eight hundred of which were in the form of clothes.
